The goals of all Biospheres are:

Conservation: promoting the preservation of wildlife, habitats and landscape.

Learning: supporting a better understanding of nature and global issues.

Development: fostering a sustainable economy and society.

- between the public and private sector encouraging best practice, developing stronger partnership working and shared outcomes.
- between individuals and communities taking responsibility for our own actions and fostering pride in a strong, fair and inclusive society.
- between business and environment realising our full economic potential to benefit people and nature.
- between people and nature valuing our natural environment and preserving it for future generations.
- between health and satisfaction enjoying the outdoors and benefitting from better access.
- **between science and art** encouraging research and innovation to become more creative and better educated.
- **between local with global** striving to reduce our environmental impact and creating places which have adapted for climate change.
